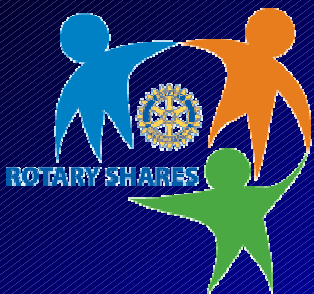

# 1. RIBI Library projects



➤ Only 25 clubs responded to a survey, out of 51 [just under 50%, compared to over 70% last year].

➤ Over 70% of the value was on top seven projects, in terms of popular support.

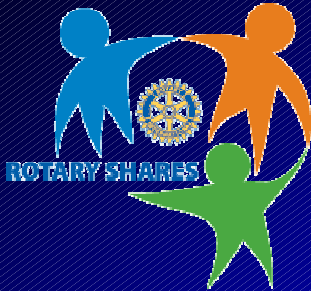

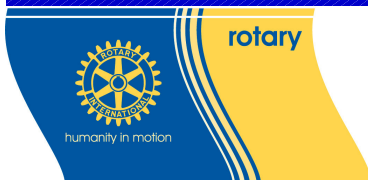

### ... WCS [World Community Service Projects]

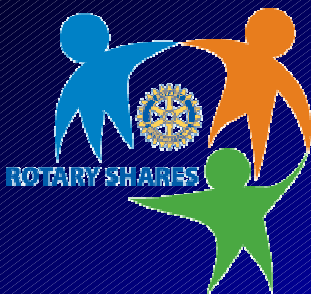


- Projects in over 12 countries, supported by £44,100\* funds.  
Some highlights:
  - Children's home in Valka, Latvia: £11,000.....*Luton Someries*
  - Sanitary Units in a community, Colombia: £4,750.....*Buckingham*
  - School-room in S Africa: £4,500.....*Hitchin Tilehouse*
  - Rural Zulu schools in S Africa: £3,800 ... *Wolverton & Stony Stratford*  
£2,000 ..... *Winslow*
